- 5) Why do you think it is a good idea for someone to step in to the shoes of someone with a disability?

Extension Activities

1) Steps to living in other shoes!

Research the physical aspects of a disability – describe how you would teach an actor how to portray the disability. For example Harry had to learn how to open the sugar with only one arm; he had to modify his speech to sound like Scott.

2) How to play Boccia

Look up the rules on how to play Boccia. Set up a Boccia game at school. Everyone playing would need to sit in a chair and not move out of it. Use soft balls to replicate the Boccia balls. Mark out the court with tape on the ground.
