Why:

Every group needs leaders and Social Inc believes that the best way to create change is for passionate students to lead passionate students, with a little support along the way from passionate adults!

What:

The Inclusion Council will consist of students involved in Social Inc. at each school, one or two Teachers passionate about INCLUSION and a Social Inc. Community Volunteer (if you have one.) The Council will be responsible for:-

- Following up on aspects of the Annual Social Inc. Survey which you may want to take action on.
- Organising the Social Inc. meetings
- Taking the initiative on events such as 'Say Hi' in collaboration with the SRC.
- Liaising with School Executive, Teachers and Volunteers
- Promoting Social Inc within the school community via newsletters, posters, Facebook, website etc.
- Attending Social Inc. events/meetings to represent the school

Who:

- 6 students for the Social Inc. Group who are passionate, willing and able to lead the group or have potential to learn leadership. The group should consist of half students who identify with having a disability and half who do not identify as having a disability.
