

'Say Hi'

When asked the **one thing** that can be done every day to make school a more inclusive place, you all told us 'I could say hi to someone I haven't spoken to, someone who is left out.'

So do it and **do it BIG**. 'Say Hi' is a campaign run at each school, often in Term 4, but do it when it is best for your school! Tip: tie it in with International Day of People with Disability and have a Say Hi Week with films and celebrations! Create an event for the whole school to show how easy it is to include and encourage everyone to Say Hi and get to know each other. Some ideas could be - hold a BBQ or gelato stall, have a chalkfest in the playground, an 'Amazing Race', treasure hunt or talent show.

What you need to do:

MEET

With the principal and talk
about 'Say Hi'.

PLAN

An event to give 'Say Hi' day some buzz!
Try to include students who usually get
left out in this process.

FUNDRAISE

Any proceeds you make go to your
school's Social Inc. Group. Approach
local businesses to sponsor your
group - they could donate some time
or equipment to your event.

PROMOTE

Get the word out!

You need to let everyone know what
'Say Hi' is and how they can support it.
Messages at rollcall, posters, guerrilla
chalk promotions, notes home &
newsletters all have their place!
